Instructor limitations.

- (A) Instructors, apprentice instructors, barber teachers, and assistant barber teachers are prohibited from providing services on members of the public in a licensed school. An instructor, apprentice instructor, barber teacher, or assistant barber teacher may perform demonstrations only.
- (B) A licensed instructor in cosmetology or a branch of cosmetology shall only teach in those cosmetology areas in which the instructor is currently licensed.
- (C) Instructors employed at career technical cosmetology schools may be assigned other school duties when not actively engaged with a cosmetology class.
- (D) In accordance with division (A)(6) of section 4713.44 of the Revised Code, a cosmetology school shall certify and file an apprentice instructor application form with the board. The cosmetology school shall employ at least one licensed instructor for each apprentice instructor. ~~The~~An apprentice instructor may be ~~used as a factor in~~counted toward the ~~student/teacher~~student-teacher ratio ~~of the school~~required by rule 4713-5-17 of the Administrative Code. Apprentice instructors shall have a similarly licensed or cosmetology instructor providing oversight when the apprentice instructor is in direct supervision of students. Instructor information shall be provided on forms provided by the board.
- (E) In accordance with division (B)(11) of section 4709.10 of the Revised Code, a barber school shall employ at least one licensed barber teacher for every two licensed assistant barber teachers. An assistant barber teacher may be counted toward the student-teacher ratio required by rule 4713-5-17 of the Administrative Code.
